It consists of the same major steps: The very first internal combustion engines did not compress the mixture. The first cylinder is used for intake and compression.

The intermittent-combustion engine is characterized by periodic ignition. Engineers have not been able to successfully harness wasted energy for any meaningful purpose, although there are various add on devices and systems that can greatly improve combustion efficiency.
