Bring your needle straight down through that point to make your next stitch. Bead embroidered cabochons are my favorite way to begin any piece of bead embroidery, and by using peyote stitch and some simple backstitching techniques, you can create lovely, secure bezels that accent the cabochons while making sure they stay put. Pass back down through the backing material as close as possible to where you came up, making sure you pass through on the guideline marked.

If you insert your needle at an angle through the embroidery medium, your beads will be secure. Pass your needle up through the backing at a point on the line you will be beading start at the beginning if the line has a clear beginning and end. You may be aiming to cover the fabric entirely with beads, but inevitably tiny chinks of backing may show. October 15, Author: I found the best technique was to start by blu-tacking a piece of paper onto the necklet.
